The "ongoing book sale" is what we call the shelves of books for sale just inside the Tualatin Library's front door. It's open to the public whenever the library is open.

Ongoing book sale materials are generally priced between ten cents and a dollar. It's on the honor system, so shoppers are asked to put their payments in the cash box on the middle shelf. The dimes, quarters, and dollars add up quickly. Last year we raised more than \$6500 for the library in the ongoing book sale!

Other people are involved too; volunteers come to the library every day to restock the shelves.
